Limited Warranty

For your protection, all Guardian Trim™ branded products are backed by a twenty-five (25) year or fifteen (15) year limited warranty. The warranty is limited to twenty-five (25) years from the date of purchase by the original purchaser. If the property to which the Guardian Trim™ product is applied is a condominium, or is owned by a party other than a resident owner, including corporations, partnerships, unincorporated associations, churches, schools, government or public entities, etc., the warranty period is fifteen (15) years. If, during this warranty period, the product is found to rot, delaminate, crack, split, check, excessively swell, or become infested with termites due to manufacturing defects, the original manufacturer will, at its sole and absolute discretion, provide replacement product, refund the purchase price with 25 or 15 years prorate (as applicable), or repair the affected product. In no instance will the cost of the remedy to original manufacturer exceed the original purchase price of the affected product. In all cases, the product must be installed in accordance with its printed installation instructions in a workmanlike manner. Each purchaser of Guardian Trim™ product is solely responsible for determining the effectiveness, suitability and safety of any particular use or application of the product. Building code regulations vary from area to area. Each Guardian Trim™ purchaser should consult local building and safety codes for specific requirements.

Claims

In order to make a warranty claim, and before the original manufacturer's obligation under the warranty will commence, the original purchaser must: (1) Within 30 days of discovering a defect believed to be covered by this warranty, notify in writing to Guardian Building Products Distribution, Inc. ("Guardian"), Attn: Guardian Trim Warranty Dept., 979 Batesville Road, Greer, SC 29651 giving full particulars, including photographs and the original receipt, in support of the claim. (2) Make available for inspection by Guardian or their representatives, the product believed to be defective, and if requested, ship the product prepaid to the above address.

Exclusions

The warranty is limited to the foregoing and does NOT apply to (1) product which was not installed in accordance with Guardian's installation instructions or installed in less than a workmanlike manner, (2) product which has been structurally altered, damage caused by fire, flood, lightning, windstorm, hurricane, tornado, earthquakes or other acts of God, (3) product which has been put in unusual service, or used for purpose for which it was not designed, (4) normal and expected weathering of the surface, any fading, peeling, discoloring or other defects of finishes applied by parties other than the original manufacturer, (5) the cost of labor, materials or the expenses incidental to the repair, removal, installation or replacement of the warranted product, (6) product which has not been stored in accordance with Guardian's instructions, (7) product which has been damaged during shipment, storage, handling, or installation, or (8) any personal injuries or damage to property resulting from the installation, use or failure of the product. (The original purchaser assumes the risk of all such injuries or damage.)

Disclaimer

This warranty is in lieu of all expressed and/or implied warranties of merchantability or of any other kind. Remedies under this warranty, as set forth herein, are at the exclusion of all others (except as to the extent required by any applicable law), and the original manufacturer and Guardian neither assume nor authorize anyone to assume for them any other obligations. In no event shall the original manufacturer or Guardian be liable for any remote, incidental or consequential damages of any nature, no matter how arising. Nor shall the original manufacturer or Guardian be liable for any amounts in excess of the original purchase price, for parts found to be defective. Some states do not allow the exclusion or limitation of special, incidental or consequential damages, so the foregoing may not apply to you. This limited warranty gives you specific legal rights, and you may also have other rights, which vary from state to state.
